## Nawiliwili, Kauai

Kauai is known as the most beautiful and ancient of the Hawaiian Islands. It took rain and wind six million years to sculpt the stunning cliffs to give this island a fertile soil that produced its lush tropical vegetation. Dubbed as the "Garden Island", it is here that Captain Cook first set foot in the archipelago while sailing from Tahiti towards North America.

On top of the Napali coast is the Koke'e State Park, which is famous for the different shades of red and brown rock formations that has produced the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific." This beautiful arid landscape can be seen on our "Journey to Waimea Canyon" or for those who are a little more adventurous you can view this pinnacle on the "Mountain Safari Adventure." If there is an island to explore from the sky, its Kauai. With so much of the island being inaccessible by road, a helicopter flight is the only way to see all of this magnificent island. Its natural beauty, blue waters, and red volcanic formations, experience it all on the "Mokihana Helicopter Tour". To see wetland taro fields of Hanalei Valley, famous from the movie South Pacific, head out on the "Scenic Hanalei" tour. Another popular sight is the Fern Grotto Cavern with its cascading ferns.
