## **DISEMBARKATION INFORMATION**

### **WELCOME TO HONOLULU, OAHU, HAWAII, USA**

The *Pride of Aloha* docks in Honolulu, Hawaii. We must wait for clearance from local officials before anyone is permitted ashore. We invite you to relax in one of the public lounges or in your stateroom until you hear your colored luggage tag called.

### **LUGGAGE HANDLING GUIDELINES**

Please pick up your luggage tags in the Aloha Atrium any time on Saturday. Remove any old tags from your luggage and replace them with the new colored tags. Place your luggage outside your Stateroom no later than 1:00am Sunday morning. Remember to keep all travel documents, I.D., medication, valuables, breakable items and liquor with you as hand luggage. After disembarking, you will claim your luggage in the terminal. **Please do not disembark the vessel until your luggage tag color has been announced, as your luggage will not be available.**

***Important Notice: Any alcohol being held in bond may be retrieved at the Blue Hawaii Club on Deck 6, from 7:30am-9:00am.***

### **5:30AM-7:30AM SETTLE YOUR ACCOUNT**

An itemized statement of your onboard credit account will be delivered to your Stateroom early Sunday morning. Any discrepancies with your billing must be taken care of on board between 5:30am-7:30am. If you are settling your account with cash or travelers checks, please go to the Onboard Credit Desk, Atrium, Deck 5. If you have made arrangements to settle your account with a credit card, your charges will automatically be billed to your credit card and it will not be necessary to go to the Desk. Accounts cannot be settled until Sunday morning.

### **ARE YOU IN NEED OF WHEELCHAIR ASSISTANCE?**

If you are disembarking with a wheelchair and in need of special assistance, please go to the Blue Hawaii Night Club on Deck 6 at your assigned disembarkation time (as assigned by the color of your luggage tag). We will be happy to provide assistance to you.
